What Are We Doing Next Week?

<u>Reading:</u> We will be reading the first story in our books called <u>A Fine, Fine</u> <u>School</u>. Our skill lesson this week will be describing character traits in a story based on actions, feelings, and motivations by the character. We will begin the discuss how to infer ideas that the author is trying to convey based on the plot of the text.

<u>English</u>: The students will be working on identifying sentences from fragments. We will be working to identify the subjects and predicates in a sentence and how to use this to begin to write complete sentences.

<u>Math:</u> We will be reviewing basic addition and subtraction problems. We will also be reviewing place value and ordering and comparing numbers. We will be working up to the thousands place value next week. Students may use Moby Max to work on their facts at home. They will have their username and password in their planners so that they can work on this if they have some time at home to do so. The website is www.mobymax.com.

Thank you! <u>Science</u>: We will begin Chapter 1 about balancing forces. Our Science curriculum is brand new this year and we have many exciting activities to lead us into a deep thinking and understanding of 5 concepts throughout the year. Each unit will take a few weeks and we will be assessing in many different ways through the lessons. At the end of the unit will be an overall test that covers each chapter in the "Balancing Forces" curriculum.

<u>Social Studies</u>: We are going to jump start our first class on Tuesday, learning about communities. We will identify what a community is and how geography plays a role in our community. We will be using Google Earth to show our tiny place in the big world.

*Your child will bring his/her planner home daily starting next week. They will write assignments and any reminders needed each day. They are to get a parent/guardian signature every evening so that communication is kept between school and home. I will check planners every morning and students will be able to earn incentives upon getting 10 points (1 per day) by getting their planner filled out and signed. Spelling Words for the week of August 28th The word wall words will be high-frequency words that the students will be expected to spell correctly in all of their writing for the rest of the year. All of these words will be posted on our word wall for the entire year.

- ☺ The second part of our word wall includes pattern and same-sound words. This will include 2-4 patterns and sounds each week and the students will be expected to spell between 15 and 20 words each week for a spelling test. However, as patterns go, there may actually be many more words that follow the same pattern, but students will only be tested on 15 to 20 of them. We will do many activities each week to practice these patterns so that there will not be any surprise words on the test.
