What Are We Doing Next Week??

**MAP (Missouri Assessment Program) testing for third grade will be April 29th-May 8. We will be taking the Math and Communication Arts portions of the test. More information will be sent home about the MAP test and schedule closer to date.

Reading: We will continue activities and reading <u>Dr. DeSoto.</u> This story is outside of the regular reading series book. Our skill lesson will be using context clues to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words. We will also create a timeline of story events.

Math: Third grade will have a test over Unit 5 on Monday. This will cover fractions, money, area, and perimeter.
