A look at next week...

Reading: We will be reading The Trial of Cardigan Jones. Our skill lesson will be to identify main idea and supporting details. We will use this week to re-view character and setting of a story.

Math: This week's objective will be to begin our first unit over multiplication. Your child should have brought an introduction letter home that explains some information about how this unit will look and how each student needs a designated "homework helper." If you did not receive this, please let me know!

Science: Next week, we will continue Unit 1 over force and motion. We will be looking at what objects magnetic forces act on.

Social Studies: Unit 1 continues as we study the geography of our surroundings. We will begin learning about the regions of Missouri and what types of landforms we would see in various parts of our state.

English: We will be reviewing the subject and predicate of a sentence as well as the four types of sentences. We will be using Kahoot in class as a fun way to work on punctuation in sentences when writing.
