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Outlook for Next Week...

Reading: The beginning of our week will begin with continuing our current story, <u>Destiny's Gift</u>. We will continue to work on character traits using text proof to back up our reasoning. We will have our short quiz over the story on Monday and then begin our next unit by discussing types of

bridges.

Math: Next week we continue to review our 5s, 2s, 9s, and 10s facts for multiplication and division. We will begin fluency on our 3s and 4s facts next. Everyone is doing a great job at learning their facts! It is important for them to be reviewing at home as well.
