Reading: We will continue our project book based on the If You Give a Mouse a Cookie book set. The students will become the author and illustrator of their own story!

Math: We will continue working on place value and also with large number subtraction with zeros. Students need to continue to review their multiplication and division facts at home several times per week. This will pay off for them!!

Science: We will work toward the completion of Unit 2. There will be an assessment on Wednesday. This is not a

test that can be studied for. Students will be applying what they have learned in the unit to answer questions about the inheritance traits of organisms in an environment.
